

Orange Unified School District District Advisory Council End-of-Year Survey Results

The information I found most helpful from the District Advisory Council meetings was:

- Budget highlights, Strategic Plan updates, Technology and School Safety updates

- Common Core information
- State Testing (current and future changes)

- Updates from District (calendar, SBA, Ipads, budget, testing) were all great. The information from presentations was helpful. I like knowing how the District came up with their conclusions and assessments; it gives us background to take back to school. It was great to have the Superintendent and Assistant Superintendents present at the meetings, thus making them more accessible.
- The opportunity to voice my opinion as a parent on issues in our schools and community, face to face interaction with District administrators, and the impression that they are working on answers to issues facing our kids

- Ideas about things I can do at home to support my child's education and well-being
- Keeping us up to date on the State's plans with budget and Common Core. Really appreciate the honesty of the District and the willingness to listen to parent suggestions and concerns

Suggested topics for next year:

- More of the same topics
- I keep coming across studies that suggest students test better in the afternoon
- Technology plans for District, Bond issue updates, plans for school site improvements not covered by Bond
- More Common Core information (in depth) and how it is going to be implemented
- Nutrition, Curriculum, teacher training, teacher accountability and explanation of formal procedures if someone has a complaint
- Although I think it is great to get information from the District, there is no formal opportunity or forum for us as parents to give feedback from school and share our concerns and ways to improve the schools. Maybe a roundtable of some sort?
- Continued information regarding the Common Core Standards and testing
- How to increase parent involvement in school and the educational process
- Earlier start for school so that first semester would end prior to Winter break
- What's being done to increase drug awareness and reduce drug abuse
- Continue on the same path, keep parents aware of changes

Any other input:

- Love all the information now on the web site! It is so helpful to disseminate this information to our parents and point them to the online resources

I also think they should all be invited, rather than one from each school. The more people who know what is going on and have a voice, the more agreement there will be at all levels.
