

 To encourage students to study other languages

ENGLISH PROFICIENCY REQUIREMENTS

- All English/Language Arts graduation requirements with an overall 2.0 GPA or better, <u>AND</u>
- Proficient or Advanced on English/Language Arts California State Test (CST)

WORLD LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY REQUIREMENTS

Complete (one of the four):

- AP exam score of 3 or higher, IB exam score of 4 or higher, or
- Successful completion (GPA of 3.0 or better) of a four-year high school course of study in the same world language, or
- Pass a district world language test TBD, **or**
- Pass a foreign government's approved language exam TBD
