HISTORY OF FRED KELLY STADIUM

- Orange Unified School District's Fred Kelly Stadium was originally built in 1969 and was named after Frederick Warren Kelly who attended Orange High School and won an Olympic Gold Medal in the 110 meter hurdles in the 1912 games. He was also USC's first Olympic Gold Medalist.
- The stadium was re-dedicated on June 11, 2005. An artificial infield and all weather track were installed at the stadium with a combination of funds, which included the Community Foundation and City of Orange.
- On **October 24, 2010**, the Office of Civil Rights executed a Resolution Agreement with the District to address accessibility issues.





EXISTING CONDITIONS





- Ongoing Office of Civil Rights Complaint
- 47 year old bleachers would be impractical to make code compliant.
- Existing areas are not accessible for persons with disabilities
- Support Facilities are Aging and Inadequate
- Non-compliant, poorly designed pickup and drop off
- Track and Field nearing end of useful life






