**New OUSD Superintendent of Schools  
Renaë Dreier, Ed.D.  
to begin August 1, 2008**



Dr. Renaë Dreier comes to the Orange Unified School District with extensive leadership experience. She has been Superintendent of Schools in Greeley, Colorado and Redding, California. The Greeley-Evans School District has a student enrollment of 18,000 students. While at the Redding School District, she also concurrently served as Superintendent for three neighboring school districts in the New Millennium Partnership which included Redding, Shasta, Igo-Ono, and French Gulch School Districts. Prior to becoming a superintendent, Dr. Dreier served as Principal of Project City Elementary School and Sequoia Middle School in Redding, CA. Before beginning her administrative career, she was a high school and middle school teacher.

Dr. Dreier is a graduate of North Salinas High School in Salinas, CA. She received her BA and MA in History from California State University, San Francisco. She earned her Doctorate in Educational Leadership from the University of Southern California in 2000. Her doctoral dissertation focused on the effects of technology-rich instruction on student achievement.

Dr. Dreier is an advocate for community involvement. She is a Rotarian and has served on the Board of Directors for United Way of Weld County, Shasta Family YMCA, and the Greeley Chamber of Commerce.

Dr. Dreier and her husband have four adult children who live throughout the United States.

The new superintendent for the Orange Unified School District is a strong proponent for public schools and she believes that all students deserve a world-class education. In order to create systems that support all students, the entire community must be involved in creating and supporting strategic goals. Student achievement improves when students, teachers, administrators, staff, parents, businesses, and community members collaborate around a shared vision for quality education that prepares all students for success in the 21st century.
