Canyon Hills Receives \$1,600 Grant from Anaheim Hills Rotary Club

ORANGE, Calif., March 18, 2010—Canyon Hills School for the Severely Disabled announced yesterday that the Anaheim Hills Rotary Club has donated a \$1,600 grant to fund a new therapy room at the school. The room will be used for physical and occupational therapy.

Canyon Hills principal Dr. Bill Gee said, "This generous donation is helping meet our need to have more equipment for physical and occupational therapy. We happen to have an available room and the timing is perfect for this to happen."

The grant will fully fund equipment such as therapy balls, mini trampolines, vestibular swings, stands to hold the swings and scooters. The timeline for completion of the room is next week. All teachers and students will have scheduled access to the therapy room.

The Canyon Hills PTA accepted the \$1,600 check from George Gillespie, Anaheim Hills Rotary President, on Tuesday. A plaque will be created and hung in the room thanking the Rotary Club for their donation to the school.
