Fairhaven Elementary Receives \$1,000 Grant from Superior Grocers and Nestle

ORANGE, Calif., January 26, 2011—The Orange Unified School District is pleased to announce that Fairhaven Elementary School has received a \$1,000 grant from a partnership between Superior Grocers and Nestle Foods as part of their effort to enrich educational programs.
