OUSD Appoints Kenneth Miller, Ed.D. Administrative Director, Student and Community Services

ORANGE, CA – April 18, 2014 – The Orange Unified School District Board of Education appointed Kenneth Miller, Ed.D. to the position of Administrative Director of Student and Community Services last night during their regular session meeting. This appointment will take effect July 1, 2014.

Dr. Miller holds a Doctoral degree in Administration and Leadership from the University of Southern California, a Master's degree in Educational Administration from Azusa Pacific University and a Bachelor's degree in Political Science from Sonoma State University.

"I am honored to serve the Orange Unified School District community as Administrative Director, Student and Community Services. I look forward to the opportunity to be a servant leader of a cohesive team that will meet the needs of all of our students, parents, staff and administration," stated Dr. Miller.

Dr. Miller has been principal at Cerro Villa Middle School since July 2010, before which time he spent three years as an assistant principal at El Modena High School. Prior to coming to Orange Unified School District, Dr. Miller was a high school vice principal at Downey Unified. He has also worked as a high school teacher and football coach.

The Orange Unified School District educates approximately 30,000 students in the Cities of Orange, Villa Park, Anaheim, Garden Grove, Santa Ana and county areas. The school district, founded in 1953, encompasses 108 square miles. The District office is located at 1401 N. Handy Street, Orange, California.
