New Administrators Appointed to OUSD Schools

ORANGE, CA – July 25, 2014 – The Orange Unified School District (OUSD) Board of Education appointed Heather Bosworth to the position of Principal and Jeff Jones to the position of Assistant Principal during their regular session meeting on July 24.

Heather Bosworth was appointed Principal of Sycamore Elementary School. She previously served OUSD successfully as Coordinator, 21st Century Teaching and Learning, in the Office of K-12 Curriculum, Instruction and GATE. Prior to joining OUSD, Ms. Bosworth was a classroom teacher, teacher leader, and professional developer in the Laguna Beach Unified School District, and taught in Capistrano Unified School District as well. Ms. Bosworth has significant experience and training in the areas of professional development for teachers, instructional technology, and elementary curriculum and assessment. She holds a Bachelor's degree in Child and Adolescent Studies and Master's degree in Education and Reading from California State University, Fullerton, as well as a certificate in Gifted and Talented Education (GATE) from UC Irvine. Ms. Bosworth is a National Board Certified Teacher who holds professional educational credentials in Multiple Subject Teaching, Reading Instruction Specialist, and Administrative Services.

Jeff Jones was appointed to the position of Assistant Principal at Villa Park High School. He previously served as a physical education teacher at Cerro Villa Middle School- a position he has held since 2005. In addition to his duties as teacher, Mr. Jones has been a department chair, administrative designee, PBIS coach, anti-bullying team facilitator, and school site council-staff representative. Prior to working in Orange Unified, he was a teacher in Torrance Unified School District. He holds a Bachelor's degree in Kinesiology and Physical Education from California State University, Long Beach, and Master's degree in Educational Administration from Concordia University. Mr. Jones has earned credentials in Single Subject Teaching, Physical Education, and Administrative Services.
